THE LOW-INCOME TAXPAYER CLINIC (LITC)

Funding for the Low-Income Taxpayer Clinic
(LITC) is provided by the Internal Revenue Service.

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What is the Low-Income Taxpayer Clinic? (LITC)

LITC is a free service provided by Community Legal Services of Mid-Florida for low to moderate income taxpayers who need help with tax matters and controversies. We do not assist with tax preparation except prior year returns associated with resolving a tax controversy.

While most taxpayers *do* want to comply with tax laws, they often need help from tax professionals.

We explain things in plain non-technical terms. When needed, we provide assistance to our clients in Spanish and Creole.

We never charge a fee, even for representing a client at the IRS office or in U.S. Tax Court. Eligibility for our service is based on income, assets, and family size. CLSMF offers LITC services in 12 counties;

Brevard, Citrus, Flagler, Hernando, Lake, Marion, Orange, Osceola, Putnam, Seminole, Sumter and Volusia counties.

Although the LITC receives funding from the IRS, the clinic and its employees are not affiliated with the IRS. A taxpayer's decision to use the LITC will not affect the taxpayer's rights before the IRS
