- Accessing other public benefits; Unemployment, Social Security, Disability, Food Stamps, etc.
- Foreclosure and other housing problems including Landlord Tenant Issues
- Access to healthcare and mental health resources
- Consumer Law
- Filing appeals with United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims
- Defending inappropriate discharge, discharge characterization or disability rating
- Filing claims with Veterans Affairs for increased disability ratings.
- Other legal issues depending on county of residence
- Family Law
